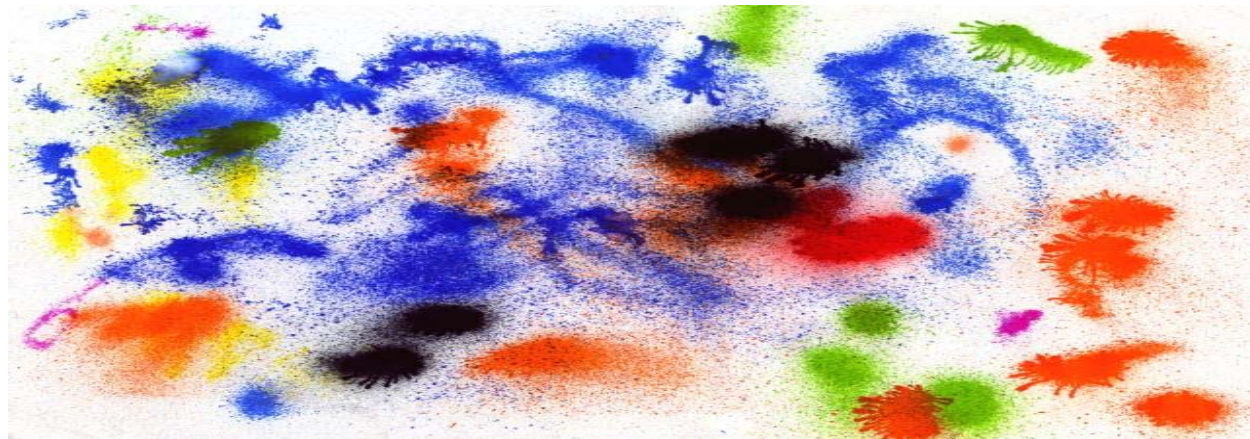

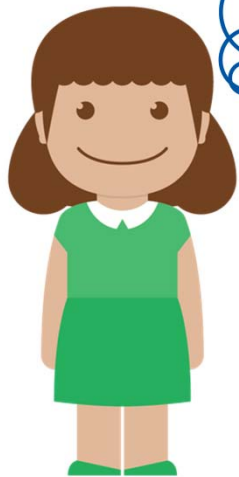

# Performance Profiles

- The 2015-2016 school year was a learning year.
- LDE is not drawing attention to Practice Performance Profiles.
- There were no consequences, though “Unsatisfactory” programs are receiving extra supports.
- Performance profiles based on the current school year (2016-2017) will be the first official profiles.
- These profiles will be released in Fall 2017 and will be based on CLASS scores collected in Fall 2016 and Spring 2017.
- LDE will publicize these profiles.

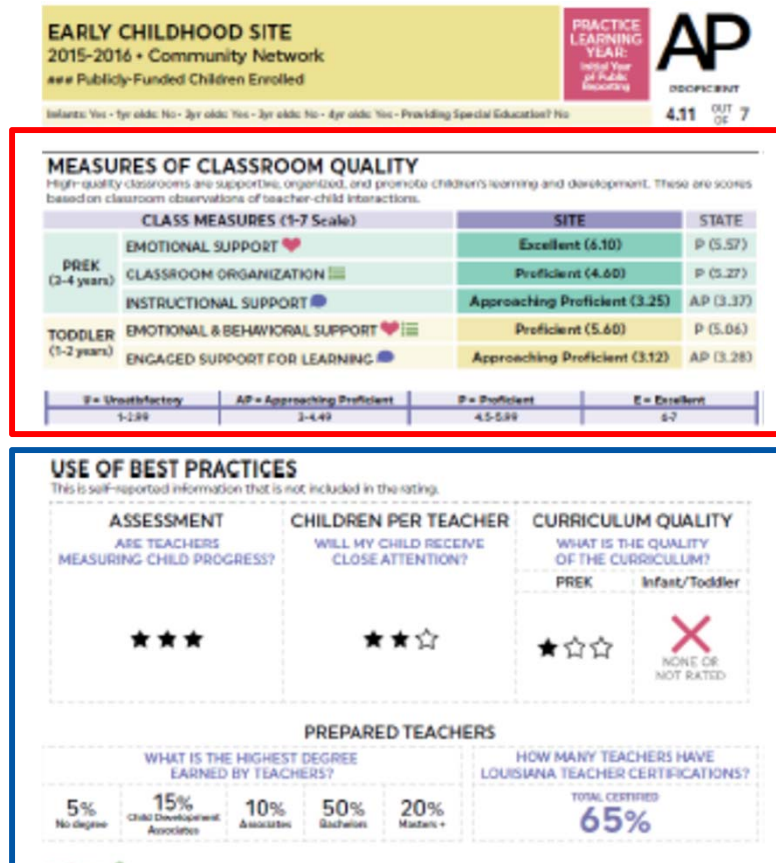
# Data Sources for the Performance Profiles

# How is my Rating Calculated?

**The Performance Profile Rating is based on an average of fall and spring CLASS Scores.**

The score is based on an average of all of the dimensions (not domains) for all of the classrooms that are assessed. Negative Climate is not included in the average.

Local (NOEEN) observations are used for the scores used to calculate a program's rating, unless the local score for a classroom differs by more than a point (either higher or lower) in the domain average.

- If the local domain average differs by more than one point for that classroom, the Picard score will replace the Lead Agency score in that domain.
- If the local observer domain averages are all within one point of the third party domain averages for that same classroom in that same semester, only local scores will be used to calculate your program's rating.

# Assessment

- The assessment metric shows that publicly-funded children are being assessed and that checkpoint levels are finalized in GOLD.
- The LDE has indicated they plan to consider information on teacher reliability and accuracy in the future.
