Our new Intensive Summer CDA program is designed especially for teachers who would like a CDA, but do not qualify for a Louisiana Pathways scholarship. This includes teachers at Type III centers with 80+ clock hours of training, as well as teachers & paraprofessionals working at public schools or private schools with NSECD.

You can expect:

- lots of hands-on activities to help you put what you learn in class into practice
- guest lecturers from child-focused organizations
- mentoring and coaching

WHO: Teachers at Type III centers, public schools & private schools participating in NSECD

WHEN: June 2017 - July 2017

SCHEDULE: 2 pm-5 pm on Tuesdays & Thursdays and
9 am - 12 pm on Saturdays

WHERE: Agenda for Children (8300 Earhart Blvd., New Orleans)

HOW: Download an application & apply by April 17th!

All participants will be eligible to receive a stipend if they successfully complete the course and attain a CDA credential. There will also be a limited number of additional stipends available for participants currently employed by Type III centers.

The Intensive Summer CDA is completely free and participants do not have to be eligible for a Louisiana Pathways scholarship.
