# Closing Main Round Statistics 2016

Over 6,000 Applications Submitted, 72% verified

- Incomplete applications did not include any school choices, were duplicates, wrong age, etc.
- An estimated 639 CCAP applicants are included in this total; est. 850 continuing students are also included here; continuing students were not required to complete apps this year. Without these groups total applications would be 4,525.

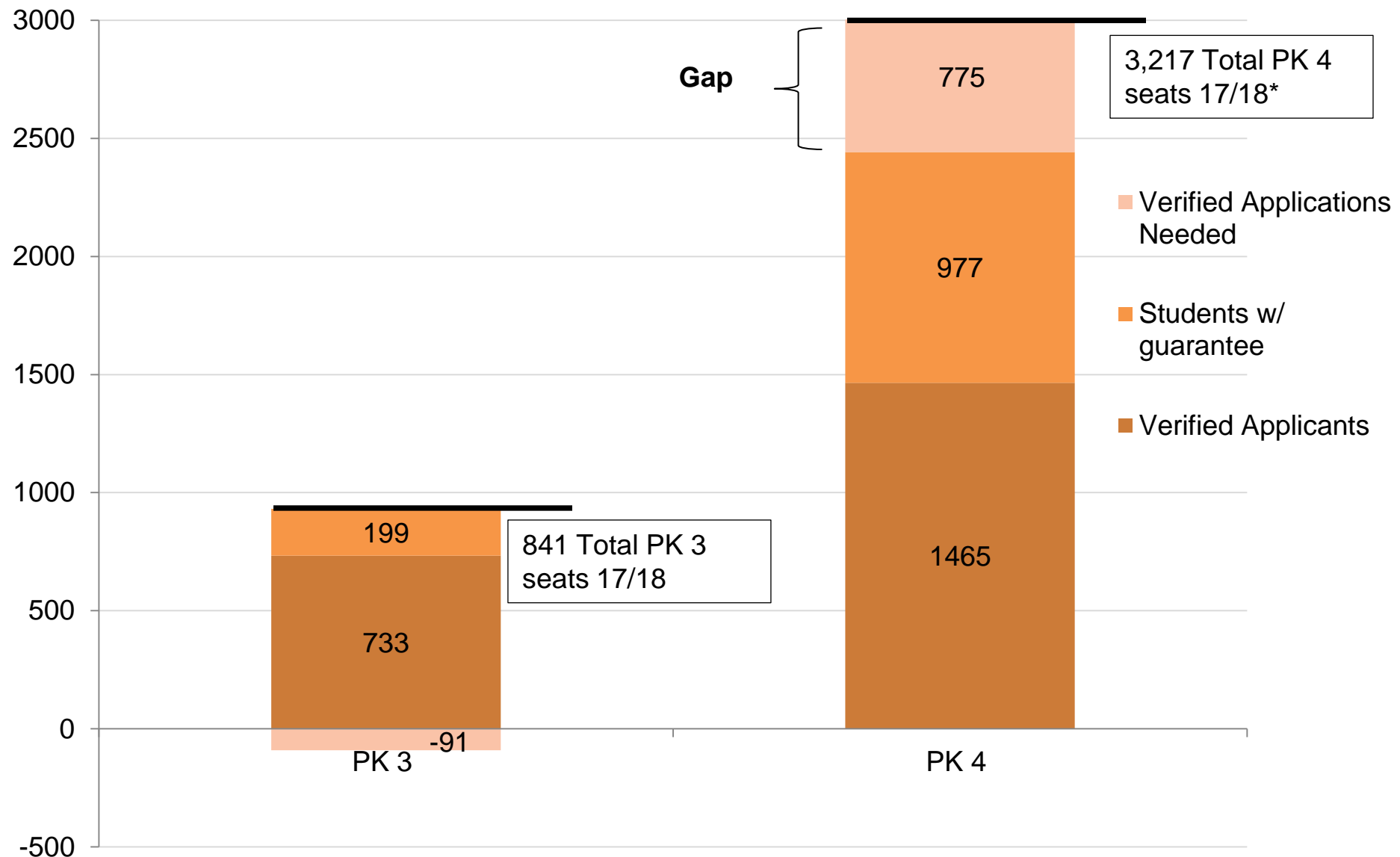

\*Preliminary results

- 78% of PK 4 applicants completed verification, compared to 75% last year, but verified applications for PK 4 are down by 470 from last year. May account for a higher number of continuing Head Start students this year who were not required to apply.
- Estimates show that there will be over 1,000 PK 3 seats next year and there are an estimated 3,100 PK 4 seats including tuition seats.

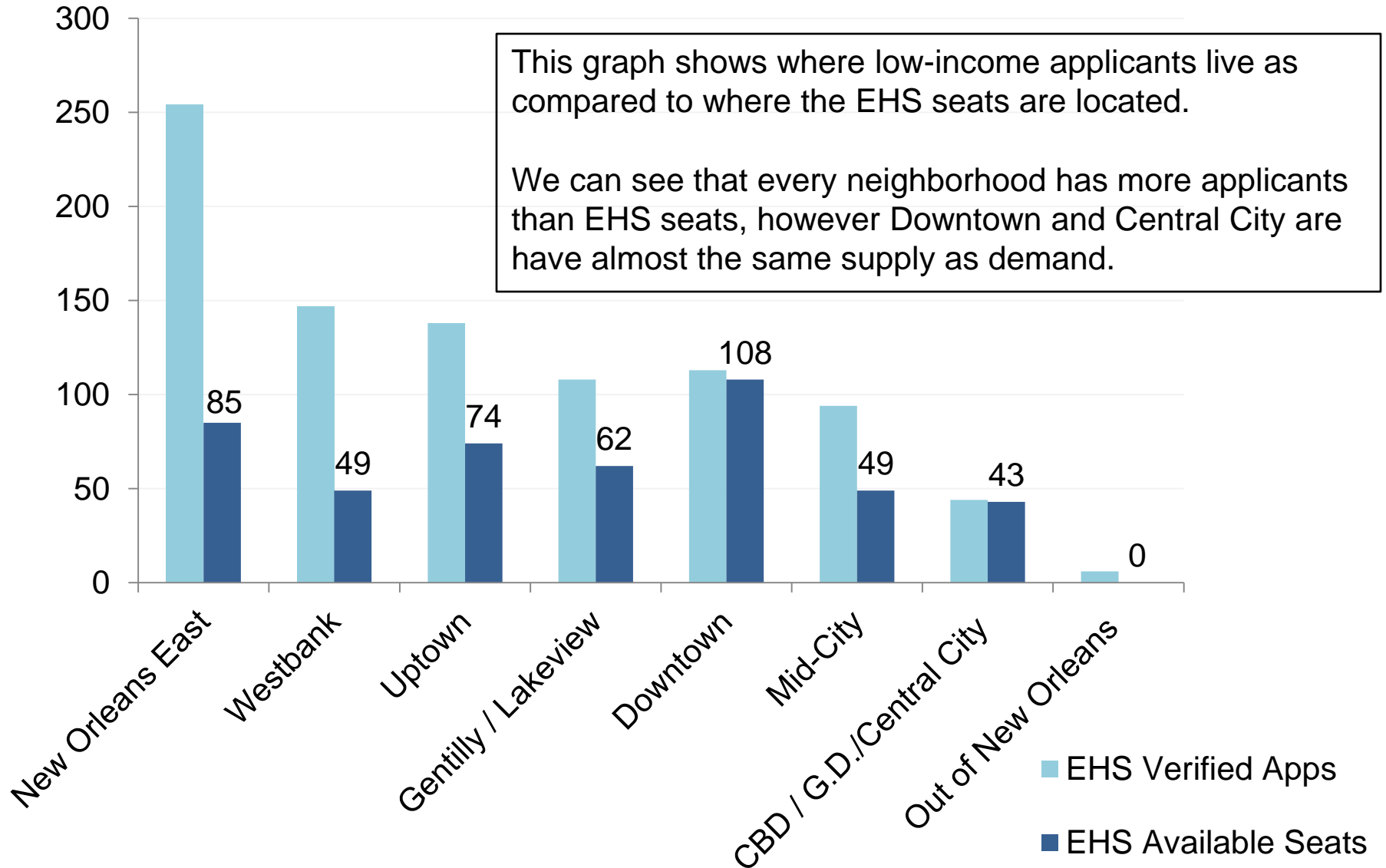
# MR 17/18: Applications & Guarantees 2017

# Applicants Versus Seats by Area 2017

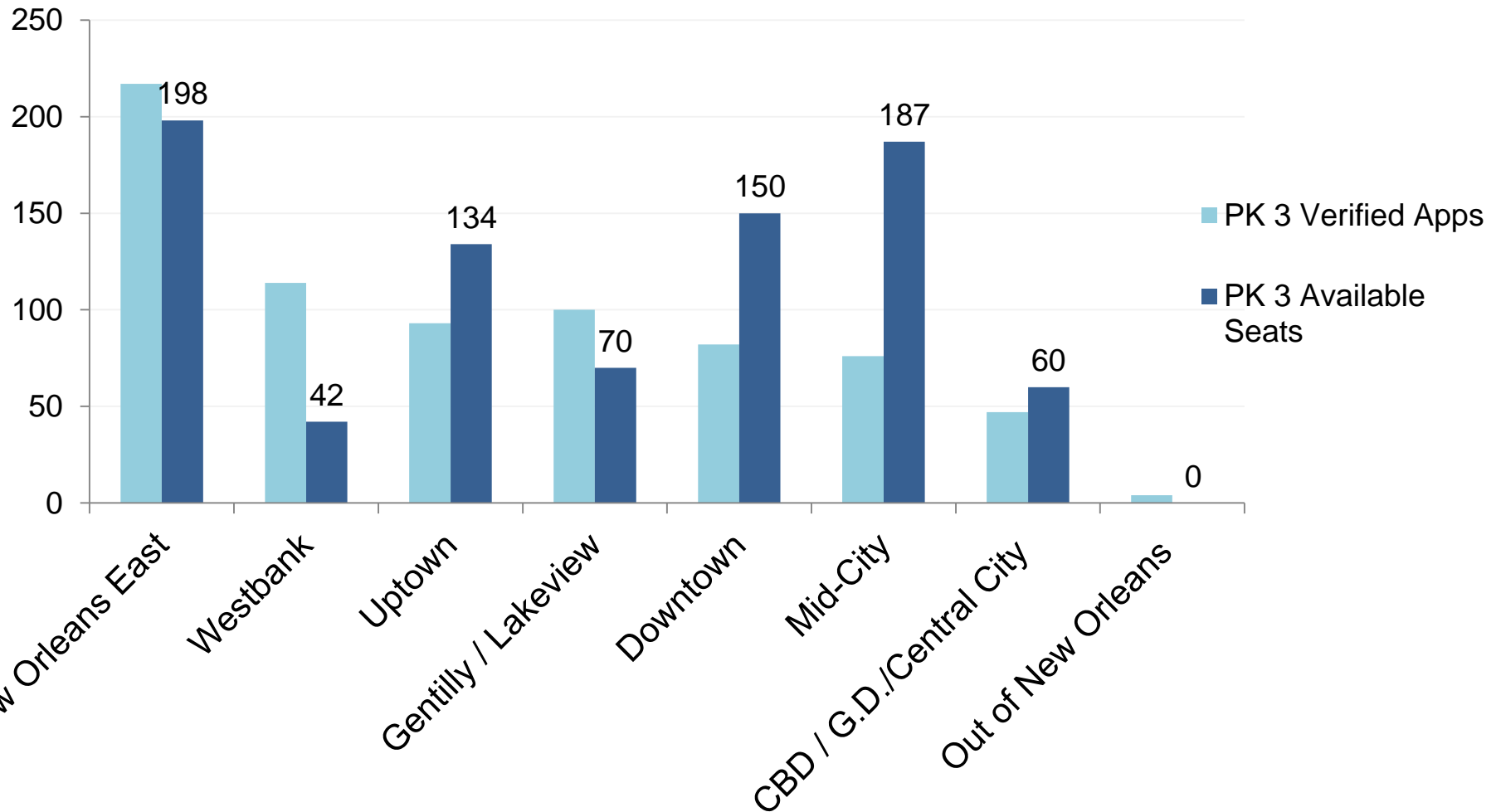
## Applicants Versus Seats by Area- EHS

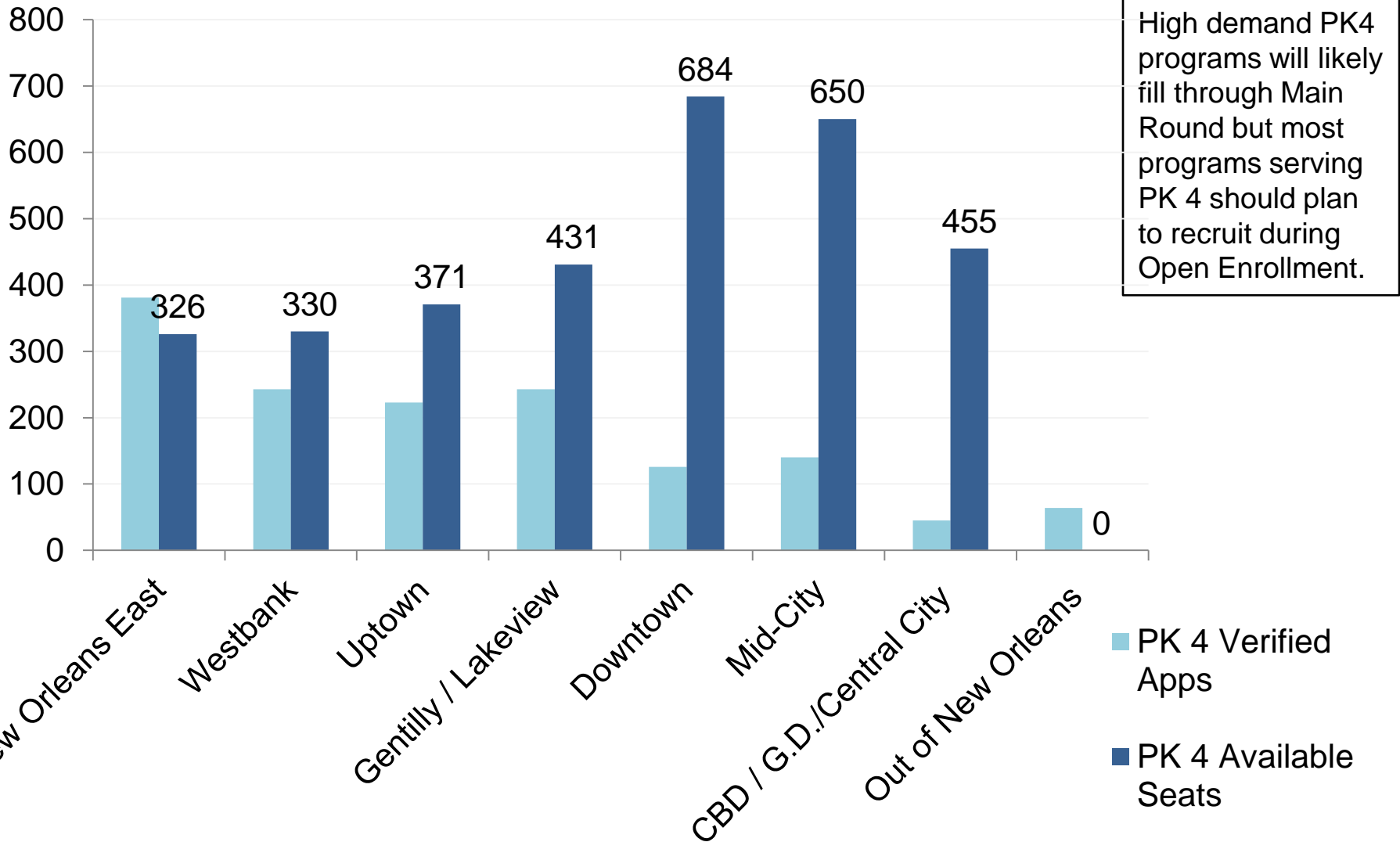
## Applicants Versus Seats by Area- PK3

Only centers in New Orleans East, the West Bank, and Gentilly/Lakeview have more available PK 3 seats than low-income applicants. High demand centers in the other areas may still fill but many will likely need to recruit during Open Enrollment.

# Open Enrollment

- Reminder there is no Round 2. Families will be notified of their Main Round results the week of April 10<sup>th</sup>.

## **April 17<sup>th</sup> Open Enrollment begins**

- For programs with waitlists after Main Round: EnrollNOLA will fill seats vacated when parents decline placement, and for Head Start, when students are ineligible for placement.
- For programs that did not fill during Main Round: EnrollNOLA and Head Start centers will complete eligibility verification for families who have not completed that process during Main Round and add families to waitlists for Head Start and PK 4 programs.

## **What should schools/centers do during Open Enrollment?**

- Schools and centers with open seats should hold recruitment events, join EnrollNOLA recruitment events, and direct all interested families to a Family Resource of Head Start center to complete the process. FRCs and Head Starts will:
  - Add verified families to waitlists
  - Verify families new to the process and add to waitlists
  - Next step for a waitlisted family: Wait for call when seat is available



# Open Enrollment Transition to Late Enrollment

## **Open Enrollment ends**

- June 28<sup>th</sup> - Open Enrollment ends for system maintenance
- Between June 29<sup>th</sup> and July 10<sup>th</sup> no early childhood or K-12 placements or waitlist offers will be made.

## **Late Enrollment begins**

- July 12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup>- Late Enrollment begins for K-8 and PK 3 and PK 4 programs, includes Head Start for PK 3 and PK 4
- July 10<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> - Families seeking EHS placements for 17/18 may be directed to an EHS center to complete EC eligibility check and be added to waitlists.
- July 19<sup>th</sup>- Waitlist offers for 17/18 resume, all programs.
- Placements for 17/18 will continue for early childhood through out the school year until all seats are filled.
