

## NOEEN Coordinated Enrollment Assessment 2017

Question	Answer
1. During the 2016-17 school year, did multiple partners (e.g., schools, Head Start, and child care) meet to discuss ways to better coordinate enrollment efforts?	<b>Yes</b>
2. During the 2016-17 school year, did multiple partners (e.g., schools, Head Start, and child care) create a joint plan to improve enrollment coordination?	<b>Yes</b>
3. In preparation for the 2017-18 school year, did all, some, or no partners in your community network conduct any joint enrollment or registration events where multiple partners were represented?	<b>All</b>
4. In preparation for the 2017-18 school year, did informational materials (e.g., brochures, flyers, websites, etc.) in your community network include information about all partners, some partners, or none at all? For example, does a Head Start brochure talk about local options in child care and pre-K?	<b>Some</b>
5. In preparation for the 2017-18 school year, were all, some or no partners in your community network able to discuss other programs with families? (e.g., a pre-K school discussing eligibility for child care or Head Start)	<b>All</b>
6. In preparation for the 2017-18 school year, did all, some or no partners in your community network refer families who they could not serve to other partners (i.e., family is ineligible or on waitlist, partner is out of slots, etc.) For example, a family who did not qualify for child care referred to Head Start or pre-K?	<b>All</b>
7. In preparation for the 2017-18 school year, did all, some or no partners in your community network conduct enrollment during the same time period?	<b>All</b>
8. In preparation for the 2017-18 school year, did all, some or no partners in your community network use the same enrollment application?	<b>All</b>
9. In preparation for the 2017-18 school year, were families able to indicate their ranked preference for all, some or no partner types on an application (e.g., prefer ABC child care first, XYZ pre-K second, etc.)?	<b>All</b>
10. In preparation for the 2017-2018 school year, have all, some or no partners in your community network coordinated efforts to ensure that no family has been accepted into more than one day program for the 2016-17 school year (e.g., accepted into pre-K and Head Start or child care)?	<b>All</b>
