- Almost a thousand more applications than end of Main Round last year.
- 371 more verified applicants when compared to last year.

- Citywide, there were 137 open PK 4 seats.
 - 36 schools or centers had open seats, 15 of those had 4 or more open seats.
- PK 4 programs in schools had 68 open seats citywide which is notable because most of these programs offer yellow bus transportation, which is desired by families.
- Many Head Start programs reduced their overall vacancies by moving open PK 4 seats to PK 3 where they were easier to fill.

- This chart shows:
 - the number of programs that are full for PK 4,
 - the total number programs for that funding source and
 - the percentage of programs with seats that are full.
- Head Start is the program with the highest percentage of seats filled, likely due to the ability to move PK 4 seats to PK 3 where they could fill.

Open Enrollment

What is Open Enrollment?

- If a family misses the OneApp Main Round but is still seeking an early childhood placement for the upcoming school year, they can enroll into open seats or be added to waitlists during Open Enrollment. Open Enrollment is a first-come, first-served process.

What is the timeline for Open Enrollment?

- Open Enrollment begins for early childhood families on April 23rd and ends on June 27th for system maintenance. K-12 families may apply in OneApp Round 2.

What should schools/centers do during Open Enrollment?

- Schools and centers with open seats should hold recruitment events.
- Direct all interested families to an EnrollNOLA event/FRC to finish the process.
 - Families who completed a MR application or EC Eligibility check and got verified can be added directly to desired open seats and/or waitlists.
 - Families new to the process should bring their documents to complete verification and choose a seat or get added to waitlists.
 - Next step for an assigned family: Complete registration at the school or center!

Open Enrollment Transition to Late Enrollment

Open Enrollment ends

- June 27th - Open Enrollment ends for system maintenance
- Between June 28th and July 16th no early childhood placements or waitlist offers will be made.

Late Enrollment begins

- July 9th to 12th- Late Enrollment begins for K-12 ONLY
- July 9th to 12th - Families seeking EHS or HS placements for 18/19 will be directed to an EHS or HS center to complete EC eligibility check and be added to waitlists.
- July 16th- Waitlist offers for 18/19 resume, all programs.
- PK 4 placements at Family Resource Centers resume July 16th.
- First-come, first-served placements will continue for early childhood through out the school year until all seats are filled.
