# Application Closes February 26

Over 3,417 Applications Submitted, 30% verified

- Verifications continue to be a point of vulnerability but have increased to 30%
  - EnrollNOLA continues to call and email unverified applicants to remind them of this critical step in the process
  - EnrollNOLA will also set up verification stations at the Expo; encouraging Head Start partners to do the same
  - Ads are shifting now from complete your application to “Get Verified”
  - Will engage a direct mail campaign to PK4 entering to K and Infant to 3 applicants
- PK4 applications up 82% from same time last year

# What's New for Round 2

## Addition of New Programs

- Schools, centers, or nonpublic schools that are granted seats for new programs by BESE in March as part of the funding request will be added to the application for Round 2

## Improvements to the Process

- Reconvene the coordinated enrollment working group to review and revise Catalog for Round 2; 2-3 meetings by mid-March to offer edits
- Working with OPSB Office of Child Search to improve the application and placement experience for SPED families
- Working with LDOE to define how best to fill CCAP seats through the application and through Late Enrollment
